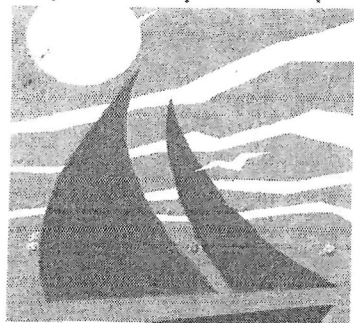

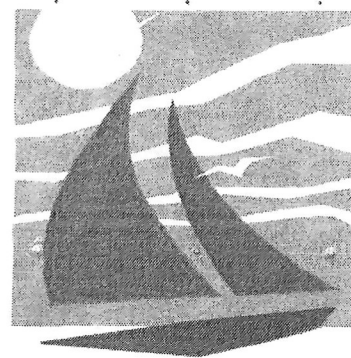

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President's Corner



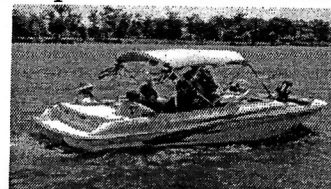
Greetings Friends and Neighbors;

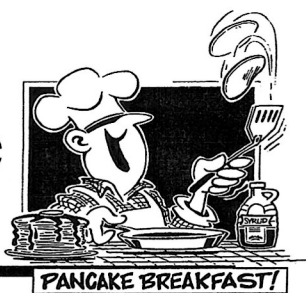
Show Your American Spirit Join In the 7th of July Boat Parade

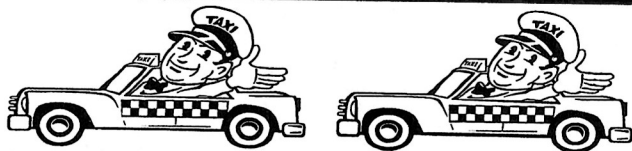
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Snug Harbor Volunteer Taxi Service

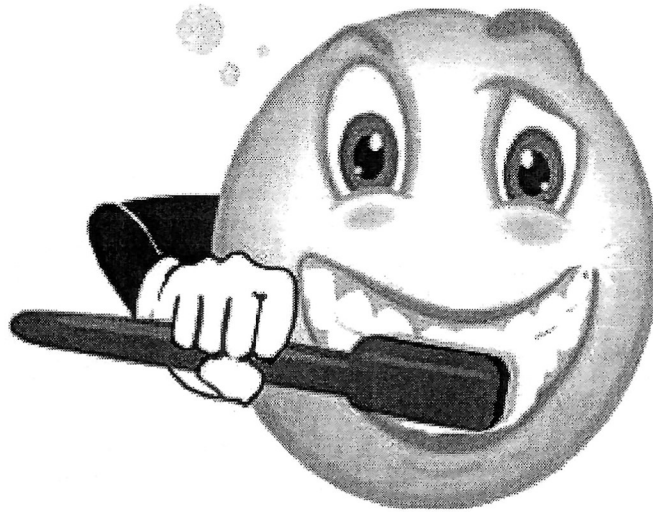


Community Watch

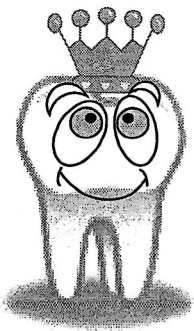


SCHOOL IS OUT! There will be idle time for many individuals. Please be observant of your surroundings and individuals walking/driving in your neighborhood. If you don't know who they are, call the Sheriff Department at 426-5615 and give them a description. This kind of action may help prevent problems from occurring or provide information that law enforcement could use. It is our community members who alert others who really help make a difference. Recent incidents include two individuals detained in the vandalized home on Fir Street. Two people arrested for trespassing and breaking and entering in the pool and pump-house area, and some vandalism in the bathrooms that have flooded out the septic systems. One individual was convicted of trespassing and restricted from SHPOA property for 6 months. That's it for now. Be alert, report ANY suspicious person or activity. If you need help, holler. Don't forget that the Sheriff's Department is on our side. Be safe.

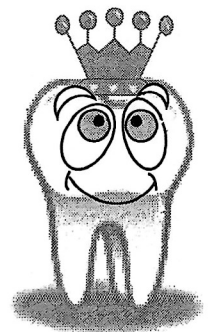
